## **ISA AGE ELIGIBILITY POLICY**

### Purpose:

Eligibility to compete in ISA Competitions and Representative Teams.

### Statement:

To participate in the ISA Sporting Competitions and Representative Teams, a student must be no older than 19 years (i.e. cannot turn 20 in the Calendar year) and studying a minimum of 4 units or the equivalent, at a Member School. Age is taken as at 31<sup>st</sup> December of the year in which the competition commenced.

### **EXCEPTION:**

- To participate in the ISA Rugby competition, a student must be no older than 18 years. Players turning 19 in the year of competition seeking to play down in the ISA Opens Rugby Competition, may be put forward by their school to undergo the Age Dispensation procedure.
- Students turning 19 in the year of competition are ineligible to trial for ISA Rugby Representative Teams.

It is noted that there are Age limitations for NSWCIS Representative teams and higher levels of representation.
