Access to Sport:

The ISA is an inclusive association where all students are given the opportunity to play sport or be involved in sporting activities for their school regardless of gender, race, culture, religious belief, age, or disability.

The ISA recognises that participation in school sports programs is an important aspect of developing positive self-esteem and a connection to school and community. Member schools aim to educate and produce good citizens by providing the best possible opportunities for its students to develop and grow through sporting experiences that directly relate to the adoption of positive life skills.

Adopting well-informed and inclusive policies for the participation of Gender Diverse athletes according to their affirmed gender identity is consistent with the educational values of equity and fairness for all students.

Students with Disabilities

The ISA will work with AGSV Member Schools to provide students with disabilities opportunities to play sport in settings where they may compete with students with or without disability, as reasonable and appropriate in the circumstances.

Gender Diversity

The ISA will work with ISA Member Schools and other School Sport structures to endeavour to provide opportunities for students to compete regardless of their affirmed gender identity.
